

## ➔ During the PreMaster

PreMaster's students are offered a specific support throughout their 1<sup>st</sup> semester to identify a school within the Network "n+i" that is prepared to welcome them during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the PreMaster.

Students will continue their studies in one of the Network's schools on condition that the PreMaster is validated.

## ➔ After the PreMaster

### Option 1 ➔ A guaranteed student-status Master's degree

On condition that the PreMaster is validated (60 ECTS credits awarded), students will carry on their Master's degree studies in one of the Network "n+i" schools.

N.B.: EI CESI has been appointed by Network "n+i" to handle the PreMaster's organization for all schools. Students will therefore be automatically enrolled in EI CESI for the PreMaster's 1<sup>st</sup> semester, and will be transferred from the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to the school they have selected to continue their Master's degree.

### Option 2 ➔ An employee-status Master's degree

Since 1987, one can graduate from a French higher education institute by integrating an apprenticeship program combining academic instruction with on-the-job training, through an apprenticeship contract.

Today, more than 15% of graduates are apprentices.

This 2-year employee-status apprenticeship training program leads to an engineering degree that is recognized by CTI, a French accreditation structure. Apprentices benefit from companies' financial support for their trainings, along with monthly salaries and, having reached the end of their trainings, from first professional experiences in companies in France.
